**Aware that** as per the Daily Nation newspaper report dated Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> April,2018 Kenya faces the risk of losing half of its maize crop and face massive food crisis following an invasion of the Fall army worms; **Further ware that** based on the same report 30 Million- 90 Kilograms bags of maize were consumed by the worms in 2017; **Concerned that** there seems to be no mitigation measures by the nation and specifically County Government of Uasin Gishu on how they intend to forestall the Fall army worm attack; **Noting that** maize is the staple food for about 80% of the population and any shortfall will cause an increase in the price of maize meal and thus result in adverse economic consequences to the nation and by extension our County :This County Assembly urges the County Government of Uasin Gishu through the Department of Agriculture to immediately mobilize and sensitize the farmers on preventive and protective measures so as to enable farmers stop the Fall army worm attack.
