**8. MOTION (HON. DAVID SINGOEI - MCA NGENYILEL WARD)**

**Aware**, that there is rampant business on alliterated fuel which is spearheaded by unscrupulous traders in the County and specifically Turbo, Jua Kali, Kosachei, Kipkaren and other urban and peri-urban areas; **Further Aware that** the use of this fuel causes much economic losses to the Country, County and Motor Vehicle owners in terms of revenue, maintenance costs and low combustion; **Concerned that** this illicit trade has been in existence for so long and no effective action has been taken to stop it; **Further Concerned** that this practice is conducted in contravention of County Government laws, NEMA, Acts and Kenyan laws and other relevant government agencies; **Noting that** this illegal business is hurting other players in the same industry who have invested heavily in it; This County Assembly urges the County Government of Uasin Gishu through the Department of Lands, Housing and Physical Planning, Ministry of Environment to identify, prosecute and demolish structures to stop this business as soon as possible.
