9. MOTION (HON. SALOME BUSIENEI – NOMINATED MCA)

Aware that the Public Health Act Cap 242 provides for the Slaughter and Inspection of beef animals by the concerned officers in order to ensure that they are free from diseases and in good and wholesome conditions; **Further Aware that** the said inspectors should certify the carcasses as fit for consumption before the same are supplied and distributed to the consumers; **Concerned that** currently unscrupulous meat dealers have taken advantage of the weak implementation of the Public Health Act to sell uninspected and in some cases contaminated meat to the unsuspecting public; **Noting that** cases of people falling sick after consuming infected meat have been reported in the print and electronic media; **Cognizant that** in some cases some meat inspectors have been colluding with unscrupulous meat dealers in the trade: This County Assembly urges the County Government through the Department of Health Services to ensure that the necessary provisions of the Public Health Act pertaining the inspection and supply of meat is adhered to and thereafter arrest and prosecute all meat dealers and inspectors contravening the Act.
