**Aware that** under Article 38 (2) of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010 every Kenyan Citizen has the right to free, fair and regular elections based on universal suffrage and the free expression of the will of the electors for various elective positions; **Further Aware that** every adult citizen has the right, without unreasonable restrictions to vote by secret ballot in any election or referendum; **Noting that** General Elections will be held in Kenya this year 2017; **Deeply Concerned that** a good number of citizens eligible to vote are likely to be unreasonably restricted from voting for the reason that their National Identity Cards are being held in various Public Health facilities within Uasin Gishu County as security for pending bills; **Cognizant that** it is important that such Identification Cards be liberated to enable the owners participate fully in the coming General Elections: This County Assembly urges the County Government through the Departments of Finance and Economic Planning and Health Services to consider waiving such pending hospital bills, in full or in part, in all public health facilities within Uasin Gishu County facilities to pave way for the retrieval of the detained Identity Cards to enable their owners take part in the forthcoming General Elections.
