**Aware that** since the introduction of Boda Boda as a mode of transport in Kenya there has been a significant increase of accidents on our roads; **Further Aware** that the accidents have caused loss of lives, injured many, untold economic damages and social suffering, **Concerned that** despite the menace caused by the boda boda operators over the Kenyan roads, it is apparent that the concerned Government agency and in particular the National Transport and Safety Authority (NTSA) has not come up with solutions to the issue; **Further concerned** that nearly all the boda boda operators are ignorant of the Highway Code and many of them have never attended any driving school; **Noting that** the boda boda industry is a source of employment and income that has a potential to grow and develop if well regulated within a comprehensive framework that addresses the various issues pertaining to the sector; **Cognizant that** boda boda operations is a worldwide phenomenon and many countries have successfully integrated it in their transport system and thus Kenya is not an exception; This County Assembly urges the County Government of Uasin Gishu through the Department of Roads, Public Works and Transport in partnership with the National Transport and Safety Authority (NTSA) to develop a regulatory framework which will manage the boda boda industry in the County.
