Aware that; Any process of appointment Pursuant to the Constitution or Statutory provision that does not comply with the provisions of the law cannot be upheld as being lawful. **Further Aware that;** The governor cannot exercise the power of appointment of C.E.C/CO's without the approval of County Assembly in Reference to Peter Kylo VS Governor Machakos County Constitutional Petition No.10 of 2018. Given that the position of the Chief Officers is an authorized officer requiring the approval by the County Assembly the acting Chief officer should also be an authorized officer approved by the County Assembly **Noting that;** According to the Public Appointments (County Assembly Approval) Act Section (4) states that an appointment under the Constitution or any other law for which the approval of County Assembly is required shall not be made unless the appointment is approved by the relevant County Assembly in accordance with the same Act **Cognizant that;** The following Officers are serving in an Acting capacity without prerequisite constitutional requirements and have also acted beyond the 6 months (six) against mandatory period as per the provisions of the Public Service Commission Act Section (34)
