9 MOTION (HON. HILLARY RONO – MCA KIPKENYO WARD)

Aware that since the promulgation of the Constitution of Kenya in 2010 Counties have become the new focus for social and economic development; **Further Aware that** the Central Government has devolved much resources to the counties that can be leveraged at the local level to spur many social and economic activities; **Concerned that** since the inception of devolution, the County Government of Uasin Gishu has never proposed any policy framework, or legislation that can be used by potential local, regional or even international investors as a guideline to enable them make informed decisions on investment opportunities; **Noting that** several counties are already formulating policies aimed at attracting and luring regional and international investors to their counties and thus our county will lose if it fails to act appropriately; **Cognizant that** Uasin Gishu County is strategically located as a gateway for local and regional markets and therefore has a potential to become an investment hub if the necessary and relevant policy decisions are made: This County Assembly urges the County Government of Uasin Gishu through the Department of Trade, Industrialization, Tourism Wildlife and Enterprise Development to prepare and submit to the County Assembly a policy framework that will act as a guideline for investment promotion in the County.
