9. MOTION (HON. MOSES BARTENG – MCA SERGOIT WARD)

Aware that currently there is only one relatively modern abattoir in the County of Uasin Gishu that handles the slaughter of animals and supply of beef products; **Further Aware that** in spite of its modernization the abattoir does not meet international standards that can qualify it to produce and sell its products to the outside markets and thus enable livestock farmers get access to wider markets and thereby get better prices for their products; **Concerned that** currently many farmers who keep beef cattle suffer a lot of losses due to lack of adequate and reliable markets; **Noting that** many cartels and brokers have taken advantage of lack of adequate markets to buy such animals at throw away prices and thereby make the livestock farmers incur huge financial losses; **Cognizant that** according to the County Integrated Development Plan (CIDP) 2013-2018, the County could be an exporter of livestock and livestock products to neighboring countries if production can be improved; This County Assembly urges the County Government of Uasin Gishu through the Department of Agriculture, Livestock Development and Fisheries to consider entering into a Public Private Partnership with private developers for the development of an ultra modern abattoir that will enable the County gain access to outside markets for its beef products.
