8. MOTION (HON. REBECCA SUGUT - MCA KUINET/KAPSUSWA WARD)

Aware that this County Assembly did pass the Uasin Gishu County Bursary and Skills Development Support Fund Disbursement (Act No.20) 2014; Further aware that the objective of the fund was to make provision for bursary, skills development support and other related matters; Concerned that in its provisions the Act failed to take into consideration vulnerable groups as required by law; Noting that the Constitution of Kenya 2010 section 20(b) states that in allocating resources the state and for that matter the county shall give priority to ensuring the widest possible enjoyment of the rights or fundamental freedoms having regard to the prevailing circumstances including the vulnerability of particular groups or individuals; This County Assembly urges the County Government of Uasin Gishu through the Department of Education, Culture, Social Services and Sports to prepare a policy framework that will ensure that vulnerable groups are allocated a specific amount from the Uasin Gishu County Bursary and Skills Development Support Fund.
