**8. MOTION (HON. DAVID SINGOEI – MCA NGENYILEL WARD)**

**Aware that** milk hawking has grown and become a major source of employment and income to many residents of our County; **Further aware** that the same industry has provided alternative channels of milk marketing to many dairy farmers and thus promoted the economic development and empowerment to many people; **Concerned that** efforts of the Kenya Dairy Board to ban milk hawking have not been successful; **Further concerned** that the same Board has harassed, arrested and even prosecuted innocent milk hawkers who have tried to earn honest living through milk hawking; **Noting that** the milk hawking industry is a potential employer to many people if creative and innovative ways are formulated to regulate its operations; This County Assembly urges the County Government through the Department of Agriculture, Livestock Development and Fisheries to formulate and submit to this County Assembly for approval a Legislative Proposal bill that will amongst other things formalize, legalize, regulate, develop and promote the milk hawking industry in the County.
