9. MOTION (HON. DAVID SINGOEI – MCA NGENYILEL)

Aware that the Ministry of Health through the National AID's Control Council of Kenya has devolved its functions to the Counties through National Aids and STI Control Programme (N.A.S.C.O.P), **Further aware** that people living with HIV/AIDS have not got the proper and desired attention at the County level in terms of material support and economic empowerment so as to enable them support themselves and their dependants, **Concerned that** many HIV/AIDS people have been discriminated, stigmatized and marginalized in the distribution of resources and thus undermining their social and economic empowerment, **Noting that** the Constitution of Kenya Section 56 proclaims the state shall put in place affirmative action programmes designed to ensure that minorities and marginalized groups are provided special opportunities in economic and educational fields amongst other things, **Further noting** that the same section provides that they shall participate and be represented in governance and other spheres of life, **Cognizant that** the same Constitution recognizes and emphasizes equal opportunities for all members of society irrespective of their status; This County Assembly urges the County Government of Uasin Gishu through the Department of Health to conduct research on issues, conditions and problems facing people living with HIV/AIDS within the County and come up with policy on economic and empowerment strategies in order to improve their living standards.
