Aware that Chebororwa Farmers Training College situated at the border of Uasin Gishu and Elgeyo Marakwet Counties is a public institution; **Further Aware that** the institution has always been under management of the Uasin Gishu County Government; **Noting that** the institution has been for a long under direct management of the current Acting Principal and Acting Deputy Principal; and it has been doing fairly well; **Concerned that** after advertisement of the substantive positions of principal and Deputy Principal there has been increasing anxiety around the institution as to who is likely to fill these two positions a situation that is likely to hamper the smooth running of the institution; **Further concerned that** there is urgent need for stakeholders consultations and briefing of the surrounding communities possible change of top management in the institution; **Cognizant that** there is need to rid that process of change of any points of controversy bearing in mind the underlying issues and suspicion surrounding the placement and ownership of the college; This County Assembly urges the County Executive through the Uasin Gishu County Public Service Board to consider suspending any intended change of guard in the institution until effective stakeholder consultation and public engagement is done.
