**8. MOTION (HON. DAVID TARUS – MCA KAPKURES WARD)**

**Aware that** Gender based violence in Kenya is on the rise as occasionally reported in the print and electronic media; **Further Aware that** most of the victims have suffered immense emotional and physical pain that has ruined their lives and that of their families; **Concerned that** gender based violence issues have not been given the desired attention by the concerned authorities in the County and thus many victims continue to suffer in silence; **Noting that** currently there is only one gender based violence unit that is based at the Moi Teaching and Referral Hospital in Eldoret Town which is serving the whole county and the neighboring counties; **Further noting that** many gender based violence victims do not get the pre-requisite attention due to logistical problems and financial constraints: This County Assembly urges the County Government of Uasin Gishu through the department of Health Services to create, establish and manage health care unit centers in all sub county hospitals that will deal with gender based violence cases.
