Aware that the County Government is responsible for ensuring that our County residents attain high quality of life; **Further aware** that there is need to balance between population growth and available County resources; **Noting that** the population growth rate in the County stands at 3.8% much higher than that of the Country which stands at 2.8%; **Concerned that** unchecked population growth in the County is likely to exert a lot of pressure on the available County resources and lead to slow economic progress that may cause high levels of poverty within the society; **Noting that** the population monitoring and control measures traditionally used by the National Government have been partially effective; **Further noting** that the County Government can Supplement such measures so as to achieve appropriate and sustainable population; **Cognizant that** the County Integrated Development Plan (CIDP) recognizes the need to address most of the Socio-economic County matters based on the population and its growth rate in the County; This County Assembly urges the County government through the Department of Finance and Economic Planning to come up with a policy framework to effectively monitor the County population particularly its growth rate to ensure that the same remain of a Socio-economically sustainable position.
